

# Police Department Report

January 9th, 2006

The following is a summary of activity for the Raisin Township Police Department for the month of December.

## **Significant Events:**

On 12-9-2005 Officer Wright was involved in a vehicle pursuit that ended on Billmeyer Hwy. The suspect was caught and charged with OWI, Flee and Elude, Resisting and Obstructing a Police Officer. Officer Wright sustained minor injuries to his hand and face during a fight that lasted approximately 8 ½ minutes before back up units could arrive.

On 12-23-2005 Officer Wright assisted the LCSO in a vehicle pursuit. The suspect was caught and charged with OWI, Flee and Elude.

On 12-27-2005 Chief Lambka assisted Adrian Township on a foot pursuit on Carson near Valley rd. The suspect was caught and charged with driving with a suspended license, Resisting and Obstructing a Police Officer as well as an outstanding warrant.

On 12-28-2005 Officer Wright and Chief Lambka assisted the LCSO in a vehicle pursuit that ended on East Valley Rd. The suspect was caught and charged with OWI, Flee and Elude, Resisting and Obstructing a Police Officer, driving with a suspended license, and failure to stop at the scene of an injury accident.

On 12-31-2005 Officer Wright was involved in a vehicle pursuit that ended at M-52 and Russell Rd. The suspect was caught and charged with OWI, Flee and Elude, Resisting and Obstructing a Police Officer.

## **Meetings:**

Chief Lambka attended a Live Scan update meeting on December 1<sup>st</sup> at the Old Court House. This meeting was to bring everyone up to speed on the requirements for electronic submission of fingerprints mandated by the state. We are currently working on a co-operative agreement between Tecumseh, Clinton and Cambridge Township Police Departments to buy a Live Scan machine to bring us into compliance with this mandate.

## **Training:**

Chief Lambka attended Unified Incident Command class at Madison Township Fire Department on December 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. This class is mandated for all command staff to comply with Federal requirements initiated after 9-11.

Officer Wright attended Forensic Interviewing class on December 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> at Napoleon Police Department. This class is designed for the interviewing of juvenile suspects and victims in cases such as sexual assault.

## **Traffic Enforcement Update:**

Raisin Township Police Department participated in an OWI enforcement on December 19<sup>th</sup> - January 1<sup>st</sup>. This enforcement netted 5 drunk drivers during this period as well as numerous other violations such as suspended operators license, no insurance and outstanding warrants to name a few. We have several other enforcements scheduled for later this year.
